Strengthen Communities

- Run grass-roots projects in urban and in rural areas adversely affected by alcohol.
 Efforts for more alcohol free environments to promote inclusion, safety and foster community development.
- Advocate for evidence-based, cost-effective alcohol policies.
- Prevention programs that protect vulnerable groups in a community, and reconcile different groups in conflict areas.

ALCOHOL INHIBITS THE CAPACITIES OF PEOPLE TO BE ACTIVE CITIZENS AND CONTRIBUTE TO THEIR COMMUNITY. ALCOHOL OFTEN CONTRIBUTES TO THE FLOUTING OF SOCIAL NORMS OF DECENCY AND CONDUCT - MAKING WOMEN FEEL UNSAFE AND DEGRADED.
